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Improvements to Festival Grounds

he City completed much needed drainage improvements within the Festival Grounds near the Timber Days Pavilion and entrance to the Rodeo Grounds in June.

This project was Phase One of a larger project to increase usage in this park area. Park users will see the sand volleyball pit completed, improvements made to the soccer field and later in September Phase Two of the drainage project will commence. Currently this area is unavailable most of the year due to surface water.

From the Desk of the City Manager

he City has recently completed its budget for the coming year. Our financial position has strengthened with the General Fund balances steadily growing. Funding for Cooper Creek Water Treatment Plant has hit a snag with bond attorneys. The charter limits on the City's ability to raise utility rates has restricted our ability to guarantee future debt re-payment. The City has again initiated a judicial validation process to determine what rights the City has in making such guarantees. We hope to be under construction by the first of the year or next spring. The City is trying to take advantage of a grant exceeding \$2M and low interest loan funds, that will save the residents approximately \$4M.

The City has received initial indication that we will be awarded transportation grant funds to improve the old railroad bed east of Waite Street into an extension of the Sutherlin Creek Trail recently completed at the Festival Grounds. This exciting project will be completed in 2012.

We've completed

two projects to reduce storm water inflow and infiltration into the wastewater collection system. The contractors repaired leaks in 68 manholes, raised 9 manholes, and installed cleanouts on 23 service lines. The projects will reduce surface and groundwater that enters our system requiring treatment. This project, also will reduce sewer surcharging in the winter and reduce cost of treatment plant improvements expected to take place in 2015.

Playground has received new chips and border, as well as a new drainage system installed. The drainage system will make the park



more accessible during the winter months.

• The Calapooia water tank repairs were completed. This work corrected a slide that exposed a portion of the tanks foundation.

Finance Department: Visitors to City Hall will notice a few changes as the City recently moved the Municipal Court office over to City Hall and merged it with the Finance Department. Consequently, anyone wishing to make a court payment or talk with the court clerk may now do so at City Hall located at 126 E. Central Avenue.
