CHARGE(S): Warrant Arrest
DETAIL(S): Steege was seen in the area and Officer knew of an unworked warrant out for his arrest. Steege was arrested without incident and transported to the Douglas County Jail. A second warrant was confirmed on Steege from Roseburg Municipal Court, which was served as well.

DETAIL(S): Officer was dispatched to location for a vehicle theft report. Officer arrived on scene and learned the suspect, Malachi Cromwell, had returned to the scene without the vehicle. Cromwell started to talk to the Officer but then started to walk away knowing he had a warrant. The Officer stopped Cromwell but he attempted to escape. Officer took him to the ground and he front rolled out of the take down, popped up to his feet and squared off to the Officer. The Officer deployed the X2 Taser twice because the first deployment was a clothing disconnect. Second deployment was effective and Cromwell went down. Cromwell attempted to get but up and Officer went hands on delivering multiple elbow and knee strikes before he complied. While attempting to search Cromwell he again started to resist and Officer took him back to the ground. Cromwell attempted to bite the Officer and the Officer elbow struck him again. Young jumped on them and interfered with the arrest because she didn't like how it was happening. In the end Young didn't want to press charges for vehicle theft. Officer cited and released Young for interfering. Cromwell was lodged at the Douglas County Jail. The vehicle was located on Duke.

DETAIL(S): Reporting Party said that Chad Reams lives with at the above residence. He is disabled and does not work. Reporting Party works two jobs and worked last night. Then had a flat tire on the way home from work and didn't get home until about 7 this morning. Reporting Party had to try to sleep and go to the second job at 11 am this morning. Chad was mad because he thinks that the Reporting Party doesn't do anything to help with the kids. He wanted the Reporting Party to take the 2 year old to work with this morning so he could be alone in the house to "clean". Reporting Party had a video of their argument. Officer observed Reams being very disrespectful toward the Reporting Party and eventually there was a struggle over the diaper bag. Reporting Party said that Reams had slapped Reporting Party's face however there was no bruise or substantial pain. Reporting Party wanted to pursue charges for Harassment. Reporting Party showed me the twenty or so text messages that Reams had sent and he admitted to grabbing the diaper bag out of the Reporting Party's hand, but would not admit to slapping the Reporting Party. Officer contacted Reams and we had a discussion about his treatment of the Reporting Party and the fact that the Reporting Party works two jobs and does not sleep. He admitted fault and took the Harassment citation.
